Terms of participation The **accademia l'arte del mondo** offers eight scholarships and
place for eight additional participants each season (with the instrumentation varying
as required). Instructors and participants not only work in a teacher-student relation-
ship but also make music together. This structure affords the participants well-ground-
ed experience that will remain with them throughout their musical careers.

A_Scholarship Holders Upon selection for a scholarship, these musicians have commit-
ted themselves to take part in all four work and presentation phases of the season.
Room and board and tuition are covered by the **accademia l'arte del mondo**. Schol-
arship holders also receive an expense allowance.

B_Additional Participants Musicians selected for this group commit themselves to
take part in at least two of the season's work phases. These participants pay €200 for
room and board in each work phase. Tuition is covered by the **accademia l'arte del
mondo**.

All participants receive an honorarium for the subsequent concerts. The instrumenta-
tion of the orchestra may vary from one venue to the next.

Audition Repertoire • Candidates should prepare a solo piece of their own choice

• The audition jury may ask to perform a movement of a chamber music piece together
with the jury members »prima vista« • Tuning standard: 415 Hertz for strings and
winds. • The **accademia l'arte del mondo** will provide a piano accompanist for the
audition

Target Groups and Requirements

A_ The **accademia l'arte del mondo** is intended for advanced instrumental students
and professional musicians.

B_ Applicants for the scholarships must be • a permanent resident of the state (Land)
of North Rhine-Westphalia, (D); or • a native of North Rhine-Westphalia; or
• a current or past student of a college of music in North Rhine-Westphalia; or
• a graduate of a college of music in North Rhine-Westphalia

Musicians from other states of Germany and from abroad may apply for the places set
aside for additional participants.

C_ All applicants must play an audition after the timely filing of their applications
(see Selection Procedure).

D_ Period instruments are used at the **accademia l'arte del mondo**. (Please contact
l'arte del mondo to discuss arrangements for borrowing period instruments.)

E_ Experience with old instruments and historical performance practice is not impera-
tive, depending on the instrument
